



Open Elective Courses (OE):

Generic Elective (GE) or Open Elective (OE): Under NEP 2020, multidisciplinary education is encouraged through the introduction of Open Elective courses in undergraduate programs from the 3rd to the 5th semester. These courses allow students to explore subjects beyond their core discipline. Open Electives are typically chosen from faculties outside of Engineering and Technology to provide a broader, multidisciplinary learning experience.

Students must select a Generic/Open Elective course from the Institute's offered "Generic/Open Elective Course Basket" under any faculty.
